SANITATION / TRASH POLICY

NORMAL SANITATION POLYCART PICKUP

A normal polycart pickup is considered a pickup by a garbage compactor truck that comes by a resident once a week. Empties polycart that has been provided for that household on a day according to location in city. Polycart must have only household garbage in it. Be out by curb within 7 feet of street no later than 7:00a.m. of that day designated to residents location. Access household garbage that will not fit in polycart must be put in a container bagged up not lose, next to polycart. That includes plastic, cardboard, old clothing and brown goods. (Brown Goods) Brown goods are household items like, sofa, chairs, dressers, wooden china cabinet, mattress, old rugs, and like material but no metal items.

NORMAL TRASH PICKUP

A normal trash pickup is considered a pickup that two (2) people can load with forks or by hand in approximately 15 minutes. (Trash) Trash is considered to be that debris a compactor garbage truck will not pick up but not to include, batters, chemicals of any nature, oils, liquids, containers greater than (1) one gallon in size not triple rinsed and holes punched in them. No leaves, yard trimmings, limbs, hole cars, car parts, or household garbage are to be mixed.

(White Goods) White goods are those items of a resident such as refrigerator, deep freezers, air conditions all free of freon gas, stoves, metal cabinets, wire free of wood post, tin free of lumber and other wood or foreign materials will be picked up curbside at the cities conveniences.

NORMAL YARD CLIPPINGS PICKUP

Normal yard clipping pickup is considered to be those clippings from a residents yard to be no more than two (2) people can pick up with in 15 minutes. (Yard clippings) are grass clippings, hedge trimmings from bushes and small trees, pine strew, leaves, fallen limbs, and material of like nature that are to be put out by the curb or edge of the road by that resident. That does not include big trees or limbs. If you have a yard person that does your yard and they cut down a tree or big limb, they or that resident is responsible for the disposal of that item.

BUSINESSES and INDUSTRIES

Businesses and or industries are responsible for the removal and disposal of their own waste generated at that place of business.

Household Yard Waste and White Goods

The City of Ashburn is responsible for the removal of normal household yard waste and white goods. These items will be removed one day a week with the specific day varying by the location of the customer. These items are not to be placed in the roadway or in city ditches or storm gutters. Placement of any of the above mentioned items into the street may result in the customer being fined by the city.

Items not eligible for Pickup:

The City of Ashburn will not pickup:

- A. Any items associated with home renovation or demolition with work done by a private contractor, renter, or the home owner.
- B. White goods containing Freon.
- C. Garbage created by evictions. Once the renter's right to reclaim their property has been satisfied by the landlord, it is the landlords or his appointed designee's responsibility to dispose of the garbage generated by this process.
- D. Chemicals of any kind or items containing chemicals. These include but are not limited to paints, greases, oils, cleaning fluids, and automotive batteries.
- C. Demolition and renovation materials associated with burned housing structures.
