- Remarks shall end when a speaker's allotted time has expired.
- Speakers may respond to questions from the Mayor and Council members, should clarification be necessary; provided, however, no person shall be permitted to enter into discussion with the Mayor, a Council member, or any member of the City of Ashburn staff during the conduct of a meeting.

The public comment period is designed to gain input from the public and not for immediate responses by the City Council to public comments. While the City Council cannot assure each speaker of a specific or individualized response, the City Council will consider the public comments and any supporting materials provided by speakers.

Any person willfully violating these rules may be prohibited from appearing before the Council for a period of 60 days. The Mayor shall order the removal of anyone who disrupts or interferes with the orderly conduct of the meeting.

Edgar Perry addressed the Council about the condition of the cemeteries, especially Rose Hill. He asked the Council to take a close look at the cemeteries due to the fact they have a lot of weeds and ants. Mr. Perry said street signs can't be seen due to overgrowth of trees and weeds and storm drains are stopped up. He stated that he would like the City to look nice.

Brandon Montgomery of Herring CPA Group presented the Council with parts of the 2018-2019 audit. Mr. Montgomery said it was a challenging year for the City due to the storm, but the City still made around \$300,000 profit.

Shon Hampton of Watkins and Associates who is a consulting engineer for the City said GEFA had Subsidized Federal Funding at a low interest rate if the City wanted to submit a sewer project to GEFA. Mr. Watkins said he would help the City submit the application.

City Manager Tanita Norris informed the council that the City passed the gas audit except for one item which is now being corrected, the TIA Project application has been accepted, and the LMIG Grant has been submitted.

Before the new Municipal Court Building can be financed, the City must have limited soil and groundwater sampling completed on the lot. TTL of Albany, GA will complete the sampling for \$8,870.00.
